ORDINANCE NO. 25-01

BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE COMBINED ANNUAL
BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION FOR THE
SALT CREEK RURAL PARK DISTRICT,
COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST (1ST) DAY OF MAY 2025,
AND ENDING ON THE THIRTIETH (30TH) DAY OF APRIL 2026.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS ("Board") OF THE SALT CREEK RURAL PARK DISTRICT ("Park District"), COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. It is hereby found and determined that:

- (a) This Board has heretofore caused to be prepared a combined Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance in tentative form, which Ordinance has been conveniently available for public inspection from March 11, 2025, until final action thereon; and
- (b) A public hearing was held at the Rose Park Administration Building, 530 South Williams Avenue, Palatine, Illinois, 60074 on the 8th day of April, 2025, on said Ordinance, notice of said hearing having been given at least one (1) week prior to such hearing by publication in the Daily Herald, a newspaper published within the Park District; and
- (c) That all other legal requirements for the adoption of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of the Park District for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025, and ending April 30, 2026, have heretofore been performed.

SECTION 2. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law for the following objects and purposes, be and the same are hereby budgeted and appropriated for the fiscal year beginning the first (1st) day of May 2025 and ending on the thirtieth (30th) day of April 2026.

Each of said sums of money and the aggregate thereof are deemed necessary by this Board to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of this District during the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025 and ending. April 30, 2026 for the respective purposes set forth.

All unexpended balances of the appropriations for the fiscal year ended April 30, 2026 and prior years are hereby specifically re-appropriated for the same general purposes for which they were originally made and may be expended in making up any insufficiency of any other items provided in this appropriation ordinance, in making this appropriation in accordance with applicable law.

SECTION 3. The following determinations have been made and are hereby made a part of the foresaid budget:

- a. An estimate of the cash on hand at the beginning of the fiscal year is expected to be \$ 2,963,078.
- b. An estimate of the cash expected to be received during the fiscal year from all sources is \$5,654,651
- c. An estimate of the expenditure contemplated for the fiscal year is \$ 5,993,593.
- d. An estimate of cash expected to be on hand at the end of the fiscal year is \$ 2,624,136.
- e. An estimate of the amount of taxes to be received during the fiscal year is \$ 2,294,931.

SECTION 4. The receipts and revenues of the Salt Creek Rural Park District derived from sources other than taxation and not specifically appropriated, and all unexpended balances from the preceding fiscal year not required for the purposes for which they were appropriated and levied, shall constitute the General Fund, and shall first be placed to the credit of such fund.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby, repealed to the extent of such conflict. If any item or portion thereof of this budget and appropriation ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of such items or the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
