Preschool Philosophy

Our preschool curriculum is designed to give your child the tools and the experiences to grow and learn in a positive and safe environment. Our philosophy is to create an environment that stimulates all developmental areas of learning. Our preschool will provide a wide variety of learning experiences that will promote independence, decision-making and appreciation of the world around your preschooler.

Preschool Staff

Our preschool staff members are qualified, experienced teachers who pride themselves on creating a safe and warm learning environment. We maintain a ratio of one experienced teacher for every eight children for Prekindergarten classes. Our ratio for the Terrific Threes class is one teacher for every six children. We will be following all guidelines and recommendations by the CDC.

- Children must be the appropriate age by September 1, 2025.
- Children must be toilet independent. No pull-ups.
- **\$50 non-refundable deposit per child (not applied to balance)**

About Donut Lake

Donut Lake is a 10-acre quarry lake. The average depth is 20 feet with the deepest spot measuring 40 feet deep. The main game fish in the lake are largemouth bass. It is not uncommon for anglers to catch largemouth bass weighing 4-6 pounds. There are also healthy populations of bluegill, black crappie, yellow perch, walleye, and catfish in the lake. Each fall, the fishery is sampled via electro fishing and stocking recommendations are made for the following year based on the result. Every spring, Donut Lake is stocked with various sizes and species of fish to keep the lake healthy.

Boating at Twin Lakes

Enjoy boating at the Park District by renting a paddleboat or kayak (ages 16+). **Boats may not be reserved in advance.** All boating hours are weather and crowd dependent. Participants 15 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult. (**Note:** Patrons cannot use their own boats on either of the lakes in Twin Lakes.)

Boating Rules & Regulations

- A driver's license is required to show pro shop attendant.
- Life jackets must be worn at all times by all participants.
- Renters must be 16 years or older.
- Riders must remain seated at all times.
- No alcohol allowed on boats.
- Docking boat on island or shoreline is prohibited.
- The boat dock may have to be closed due to weather conditions.
- Failure to comply with rules may result in suspended rental privileges and forfeit of deposits.



Ice Skating

The Park District provides unsupervised lake ice skating on the **east lake (Donut Lake)** at the Twin Lakes Recreation Area (no skating is allowed on the west lake of the Twin Lakes Recreation Area). Skating season begins once the thickness of the ice reaches 8" throughout the lake and will remain allowed until the ice deteriorates below 7" or becomes soft or unstable. Please look for the green or red warning flags **PLEASE DO NOT SKATE OUTSIDE THE ROPED-OFF AREA.**

Fishing at Twin Lakes

In addition to a valid Illinois fishing license, anglers must have a current Twin Lakes fishing pass. A **daily fishing pass** may be purchased and is good for the day. Once purchased, the angler will be given a dated wrist band that must be worn while fishing. Anglers that want to fish the lake more frequently would benefit from purchasing a **yearly fishing pass**. For a one-time fee, a yearly fishing pass permits the angler unlimited fishing. Daily and yearly fishing passes are available in the Twin Lakes Pro Shop. Group rates are available by calling the pro shop at 847-934-6050. Ask about our pedal fishing boat rentals!

Ice Fishing & Safety Information

The Park District provides ice fishing on the east lake (Donut Lake) at the Twin Lakes Recreation Area (no ice fishing is allowed on the west lake of the Twin Lakes Recreation Area). All ice fishermen should stop at the Twin Lakes Clubhouse and purchase a daily fishing pass before proceeding onto the lake. Fishing is only allowed in designated areas. No fishing will be allowed in the roped off areas of the ice skating rinks. All conditions for ice fishing (opening and closing of the lake for fishing) are the same as lake skating.



RESIDENTS & RECIPROCAL SERVICES

Who is a Salt Creek Park District Resident?

If your place of residence falls within Park Boundaries, a portion of your or your landlord's real estate taxes goes to that park district. In exchange, you may receive a discounted price for Park District programs or use of facilities.

If you reside in an unincorporated area and pay no Park District taxes, you are considered a non-resident at all Park Districts. Your tax bill and your voter's registration card indicate which, if any, park district receives tax dollars from you. The Salt Creek Park District encompasses the southeast corner of Palatine, a north central portion of Rolling Meadows and a small section in west central Arlington Heights. Please refer to the map on page 32 of this brochure.

Photo Identification Card for reciprocal fee programs.

Residents of Salt Creek Park District must have a photo identification card to receive resident rates for reciprocal fees for programs at Rolling Meadows, Arlington Heights and Palatine Park Districts.

These cards are necessary to receive reciprocal fees for programs at Rolling Meadows, Arlington Heights and Palatine Park Districts. Please refer to the Reciprocal Agreements on this page.

The price for each card is \$4. Your 2026 I.D. card expires December 31, 2026. To renew or acquire a card for the first time, bring a current form of address verification (for example, a current tax or utility bill) to the Twin Lakes Recreation Area Pro Shop, 1200 E. Twin Lakes Drive in Palatine.

- Receive a refund (see refund guidelines)

Our guarantee is based on fulfilling our promise to deliver the published expectations of the particular service you have used.

Refunds

All refunds are subject to a \$5 administrative service fee, except under the following circumstances:

- Request for refund is due to a satisfaction issue
- Refund is initiated by the Park District
- Doctor's note is submitted with request
- Exceptions for golf programs (scan the QR code on page 24 for more information)
- No refunds will be given halfway through the program

Check refunds will be mailed. Payment by charge will be refunded to your credit card. Program fees will be prorated from the time of the refund request. Participants can get prorated refunds for medical reasons. But proper documentation must be submitted to the office. Certain restrictions apply to camp, preschool and golf leagues. The satisfaction guarantee does not apply to contractual programs, tickets to entertainment, sport events, golf green fees or inline hockey leagues.

PARK POLICIES & MORE

BE MINDFUL OF OUR PARK POLICIES

Public Conduct Notice

No person shall make, aid, or assist in making loud noise, riot or disturbance tending to a breach of the peace in any Park, or be guilty of any disorderly conduct therein or thereon, or collect, with other persons, in bodies or crowds for unlawful purposes, or for any purpose to the annoyance or disturbance of the other persons using a Park or residents adjacent to a Park. No person shall use abusive, insulting, or obscene language, or language calculated to occasion a breach of the peace, in any Park.

Playground Safety

A reminder to all parents: All Salt Creek Park District playground areas are unsupervised. We hope that you and your children enjoy your play experience using the Salt Creek Park District's parks. No dogs allowed in or around the playground.

Roller Blades/Scooters/Skateboards

Roller blades, skateboards, scooters and hoverboards are allowed on paved areas only. No rollerblades, skateboards, scooters or hoverboards are allowed on park district tennis courts, the wooden deck at Twin Lakes or in the nature areas.

Park Vandalism

Drone Policy

The Salt Creek Park District recognizes the popularity of unmanned aircrafts or drones and the need for large open spaces for the operation of these devices. However, the park district has to be cognizant of the safety and privacy concerns of our residents. In that respect, we ask that you please call our Rose Park Administrative Offices at 847-259-6890 for more information regarding our drone policy within our parks.

Dog Ordinance

The Salt Creek Park District enforces the following rules in regards to dogs in the parks:

- Dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6 ft. and under control at all times.
- Owners are responsible for removal and sanitary disposal of any excrement deposited by the animal on park property.
- Due to Public Health Rules, only **service** animals are allowed on patio areas around the Twin Lakes Recreation Area clubhouse, deck or tent.
- During special events, only **service** animals will be allowed in the areas where food is served or consumed.
- No dogs allowed in the water.
- No dogs allowed in or around the playground.



Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA)

Salt Creek Park District will comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), which prohibits discrimination in the provision of programs, services or activities to individuals with disabilities. We invite any resident with a special need to contact our staff upon registration so that a smooth inclusion may occur. In addition to the programs in our brochure, our District also provides specialized services for people with disabilities through the Northwest Special Recreation Association (847-392-2848). If you have any questions about the Park District's policy regarding ADA, or believe you have been unfairly discriminated against in the provision of programs, services or activities of the Salt Creek Park District, please contact the office at 847-259-6890. A procedure is available to you for the prompt resolution of your complaint.

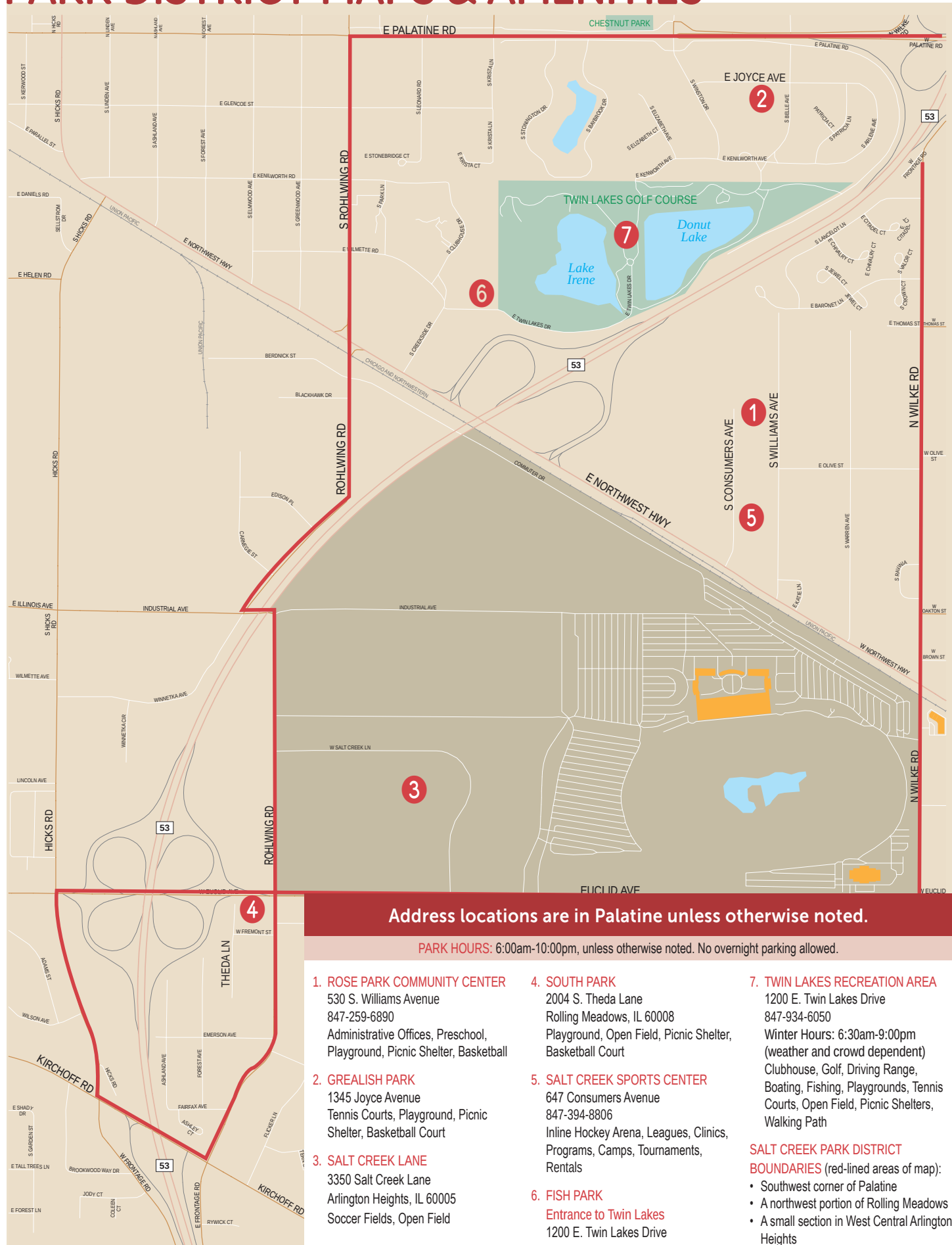
